The Nordic Swimming Federation and LTU Aquatics hereby notifies and invites all affiliated members to participate in the Nordic Championships 2026, Vilnius, Lithuania.

PLACE AND DATE OF COMPETITION

Competition will take place in Lazdynai Swimming Pool, Vilnius, Lithuania (Erfurto st. 13).

25m pool. 10 lanes, 3m deep, temperature 26,5°C.

Warm up, swim down available on the other side of the competition pool and 2-3 lanes in 25m diving pool (before and during the competition).

Team Leaders Meeting will be held on December 3rd at 19:00 in designated room at the venue.

Competition will take place from December 4th to 6th.

COMPETITION INFORMATION

The Nordic Championships will be concluded in accordance with Nordic Championship rules. In case of any discrepancies between this text and the official rules, the official rules shall prevail.

DATES, VENUE AND PARTICIPATING NATIONS

The Nordic Championships 2026 will be held in Vilnius, Lithuania from December 4th to 6th 2026.

The competition will take place in Lazdynai Swimming Pool, Vilnius, Lithuania (Erfurto st. 13).

The competition pool is 25m x 25m 10 lane indoor pool, 3m deep and 26,5°C.

During the competition, we will have shared access to the 8 lane 25m diving pool for warmups and swim downs (2-3 lanes).

Invited Nations are Denmark, Estonia, Faroe Islands, Finland, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway, Sweden and Poland (on exhibition basis).

JUNIOR (Girls, Boys): Ages 13 – 17 (2009 – 2013 YOB)

SENIOR (Women, Men): Age 18 and older (2008 or earlier)

PARA CLASSES

Classes S1–S10; S11–S13; S14; S15; S18; S19 — no age restrictions.

PARTICIPATION FEE

LTU Aquatics will charge all participating countries an entry fee of 20€, - for each competitor (relay only competitors included).

COMPETITION FORMAT

Each country may enter:

- Unlimited number of swimmers in individual events.
- One relay team per category in relay events:
 - One Senior team
 - One Junior team
 - One Para team

Finals:

- A maximum of two swimmers per age group, per country (Junior and Senior) may advance to the Finals.
- 50m events Finals – with no age group separation (Open).
- All relay events are held as timed finals in the Finals sessions.
- In mixed 8x50m relay event, teams can consist of Juniors only, there cannot be more than 50% of Senior athletes in relay teams.

PARA EVENTS FORMAT

- Events with 3 or fewer registered swimmers will be conducted as timed finals during the morning session.
- Events with 4 to 8 registered swimmers will be conducted as timed finals during the Finals session.
- Events with 9 or more registered swimmers will be conducted as preliminary heats in the morning session and Final (top 8 swimmers) in the evening session.

LATE ENTRIES, CHANGES, WITHDRAWALS, RELAY ENTRIES

Late entries are accepted until three days before the start of the first session.

Changes are accepted until the end of the team leaders' meeting - the day before the competition starts.

Withdrawals can be made until one hour before the relevant preliminary session.

Withdrawals from Finals can be made 30 min after morning session has concluded.

All relays must be entered with an entry time (sum of four individual times and no withdraw from relay takeovers).

Relay teams with athlete names (in written form) should be submitted at least 60 minutes before the start of the relevant session.

THROPHIES AND AWARDS

BEST PERFORMANCE THROPHIES

Six trophies will be awarded for the best individual performances based on official point tables:

- Junior Girls: Best overall female youth performance (based on AQUA points)
- Junior Boys: Best overall male youth performance (based on AQUA points)
- Senior Women: Best overall senior female performance (based on AQUA points)
- Senior Men: Best overall senior male performance (based on AQUA points)
- Para Women (Open): Best overall female para performance (based on WPS points)
- Para Men (Open): Best overall male para performance (based on WPS points)

All individual performances are considered, including junior swimmers competing in open events.

Only swimmers representing NSF member or associate member countries are eligible for Best Performance trophies.

CHAMPIONSHIP TITLES & MEDALS

- The winner of the junior final is crowned Nordic Junior Champion.
- The winner of the para final (based on WPS points) is crowned Nordic Para Champion.
- The winner of the senior final is crowned the Nordic Champion.

NSF - logo medals will be awarded to swimmers placing 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in each individual event and age group. The same applies to teams in relay events.

ACCOMMODATION, CATERING AND TRANSPORTATION

TRANSPORTATION

All accommodation packages will include transportation Airport – Hotel and vice versa and shuttle service between hotels and venue.
